On May 29th, 2005 we unexpectedly lost Hunter to a massive seizure. Needless to say this has been a monumental & devastating loss. In Hunter's memory, our foundation has made a renewed commitment to fight this disease and try to make sure that other families do not have to go through the ultimate tragedy of losing a child!

This tournament is in honor of Ethan Greenstein, grandson of Paul and Bernice Valove. Ethan experienced his first seizure at 6 months and was then diagnosed with Sturge Weber Syndrome (SWS). He is currently receiving multiple medications as therapy for his seizures. He is a happy child with piercing blue eyes and continues to develop normally with occasional setbacks after his seizures. We hope you support this worthy endeavor that will fund the research of Dr. Anne Comi at Kennedy-Kreiger Institute at the Johns Hopkins Hospital.

SWS is a rare brain disease with no cure or definitive prognosis for those afflicted with it. Symptoms associated with SWS include seizures, glaucoma, cognitive, motor and neurological deficits, and eye and internal organ irregularities. Hunter's Dream for a Cure raises money for children with SWS and other neurological diseases. Hunter's Dream has presented The Kennedy Krieger Institute & Johns Hopkins Sturge-Weber Syndrome Center with checks totaling \$425,000 and has committed an additional \$100,000 over the next two years. Our funding helped establish the Center, which was the first of its kind. As a result of our funding and Hunter's passing in 2006, the Center was renamed the **Hunter Nelson Sturge-Weber Center**. The Center takes a multi-disciplinary approach to evaluating and treating all medical issues associated with SWS. Long-term research goals of the Center include the development of clinical trials aimed at improved treatment for those affected by SWS and hopefully an eventual cure.
